

2021-22 Bus Transportation to the Boys & Girls Club from local schools

In order to have your child(ren) ride the bus to the Boys & Girls Club from their school you must obtain a bus pass. The **bus pass application process opens at 9am on June 7th and ends at 1pm on July 2nd.** Bus pass applications may be submitted to the CUSD Transportation Office in person or by USPS mail (online is not an option). The spots will fill up quickly, so please start the process early. We are not accepting or processing any applications, you must work with the CUSD Transportation office. Bus Pass applications received by the transportation office by 1pm July 2nd will ensure your child receives a bus pass sent prior to the school year starting. In order to do so you must complete the following procedures from each school:

Las Palmas (from school directly to Club):

- Must show proof of enrollment in our after-school program for the 2021-22 school year at the time the application is submitted. 2021-22 After-School Programs

Marblehead (from Marblehead directly to Club):

- only 18 seats available
- Must apply with the CUSD Transportation Office: http://transportation-capousd-ca.schoolloop.com/
- Pay the district transportation fees (or qualify for free or reduced fees)
- Must show proof of enrollment in our after-school program for the 2021-22 school year at the time the application is submitted. 2021-22 After-School Programs

Marblehead ESSA Students (from Marblehead to Las Palmas to the Club):

- Must apply with CUSD District Office or school site. Transportation request forms were sent out in March. We understand most have been returned already. If you've returned your Transportation request form, you will just need to be sure the CUSD Transportation Office receives your proof of enrollment in our after-school program for the 2021-22 school year.
- Parent will need proof of enrollment to request an alternate stop to the B&G club.

Concordia (from school directly to Club):

- only 10 seats available

<u>Lobo (from school directly to Club):</u>

- Pay the district transportation fees (or qualify for free or reduced fees)
- Must show proof of enrollment in our after-school program for the 2021-22 school year at the time the application is submitted. <u>2021-22 After-School Programs</u>

Shorecliffs (from school directly to Club):

- Must apply with the CUSD Transportation Office: http://transportation-capousd-ca.schoolloop.com/
- Must show proof of enrollment in our after-school program for the 2021-22 school year at the time the application is submitted. 2021-22 After-School Programs
- Must pay 2021-22 Shorecliffs transportation fee of \$350. You will be contacted by the Club to pay this fee.

Shorecliffs (from school, stops along the way at approved stops, the Club is also an alternate stop):

- Must apply with the CUSD Transportation Office: http://transportation-capousd-ca.schoolloop.com/
- Must show proof of enrollment in our after-school program for the 2021-22 school year at the time the application is submitted. 2021-22 After-School Programs
- Pay the district transportation fees (or qualify for free or reduced fees)

Space is limited, please correctly follow the procedures above to ensure your child's enrollment.

- i. Your child must behave on the bus. If your child misbehaves, they risk losing the privilege of riding the bus to the Boys & Girls Club. Refunds will not be given if your child is removed from the bus for poor behavior.
- ii. If your child is regularly using bus transportation from school to the Club, and then being picked up immediately to go home and not participating in our after school program, your bus spot will be given to another family who needs this service.



- iii. Per the transportation office, after 21 consecutive days of your child not using their bus pass, it could be revoked.
- iv. Scholarships are not available for transportation fees paid to the Club.
